

## PERSONAL PACKING LIST

ITEM	HAVE	PACKED

PASSPORT OR PASSPORT CARD		
<b><i>For night and sleeping</i></b>		
Warm sleepwear		
Sleeping bag and/or blanket		
Flashlight, headlamp or lantern		
Hot water bottle		
<b><i>For showering and hygiene</i></b>		
Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, etc)		
Towel and wash cloth		
Bathroom supplies — baby wipes, antibacterial hand gel		
Personal medications		
<b><i>For worksite</i></b>		
Work clothes (nothing sleeveless, no shorts, must be long pants)		
Work shoes (closed-toed)		
Work gloves (two pairs or more, they will get dirty with stucco!)		
Hat, sunglasses, sunblock, sunscreen, chapstick		
Insect repellent		
Water bottle with your name on it		
<b><i>For personal comfort</i></b>		
Camp clothes—shorts and dresses are okay but dress warm		
Non-work shoes		
Excursion clothes and church clothes		
<b><i>More essentials</i></b>		
Raincoat		
Hand warmers, mittens, warm hat		
Money pouch, fanny pack and/or backpack		
Bible, notebook, pen		
Some favorite snacks (one shareable from your home state)		

**Optional:** Tools are going to be provided for you but if you want to bring your own personal tools, you are welcome to do so. Wire cutters are helpful to have your own pair of.

**Do not bring:** alcohol, non-prescription drugs.
