



Update on Operations: Passports Required as of July 1, 2025 on all Amor trips

Mexico has required a valid passport for entry [since 2009](#). This is confirmed on both the [U.S. Department of State travel page](#) and the Mexican [government's website](#).

While some travelers have historically crossed the border in personal vehicles without being asked for a passport, this does not mean it is legal to be in Mexico without one.

As an organization committed to complying with federal, national, and local laws, we must follow Mexico's entry requirements. Therefore, **we cannot allow participants to stay at our camp or work on any sites in Mexico without a valid passport.**

If you have an Amor trip planned after July 1, 2025 and will not have a valid passport at the time of your trip, we encourage you to [apply for a passport as soon as possible](#).

If you need an [expedited/urgent passport](#), we are happy to provide proof of travel to help with supporting documentation.
